Playground at the Lodge

The new Lodge at the Sweden Town Park wouldn't be complete without a playground to keep young children engaged during events at the Lodge. The playground is part of the \$446,145 EPA/NYS Parks and Recreation grant that built the Lodge and will help fund a pathway from the park to the canal. This playground has been ordered and will arrive at the end of June—it should be installed and in use by July 2018. The grant was written by the Sweden Community Foundation.

Inclusive Playground

The Town has received a \$250,000 grant through Senator Robert Ort's office to construct a playground that will be fully inclusive of children in wheelchairs. The ground material makes it possible for wheelchairs to move easily among the stations and two wheelchair ramps will give children full access to all the activities on the equipment. The grant funds will be released soon, with installation of the playground in the fall.



Splash Pad

An \$80,000 Monroe County CDBG grant and a matching \$80,000 from a donor will make this Splash Pad a reality in Summer 2019.
